Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) – Advanced Placement

Summer 2013 Deadline: February 1, 2013
*****Admissions Information*****

Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) – Advanced Placement is a selective enrollment program beginning each summer. **Entry to this program is available to graduates of Radiography, Nuclear Medicine, or Radiation Therapy programs accredited by the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiography or Nuclear Medicine.** Resources such as clinical facilities and faculty, as well as approval standards, limit the number of applicants typically accepted to **5 - 8 students** for the summer. Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) – Advanced Placement is an advanced one-year diploma program and all applicants must meet minimum requirements to be considered for admission. **Please note, however, that meeting minimum requirements does not guarantee admission.**

When applicants have completed all of the minimum requirements, they must contact the Program Coordinator, Debbie Durham Taylor, at 336-734-7178 or dtaylor@forsythtech.edu, for a Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) – Advanced Placement program review. **Please do not contact Ms. Taylor until after January 1, 2013; however, do note that you must contact her by the deadline stated above, February 1, 2013.** Qualified applicants will be ranked based on criteria listed in this packet. Applicants not admitted to the program must re-apply if they wish to be considered for the following year's class.

PHASE I: APPLICATION PROCESS

The following steps must be completed by February 1, 2013 for the summer 2013 program. Please note you are **not** required to participate in an Allied Health Information Session.

- ____ 1. Complete the Forsyth Tech application
- ____ 2. Have official transcripts from all colleges or schools attended since high school sent to the Admissions Office (Official transcripts must have the school's seal or original signature in an unopened envelope.)

PHASE II: MINIMUM ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

1. Grade Point Average (GPA) Requirement

Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher to qualify for acceptance into the Magnetic Resonance Imaging Advanced Diploma program.
