Make sure you let the DMV know you will be driving for the City and do not require a Medical Examiner's Report (MER) because we are **considered "excepted intrastate."**

Identification and Residency Requirements

If you have ever held a Virginia driver's license or ID card, you must present the following:

Current Virginia license or ID AND One of the following federally required documents:

- Valid, unexpired U.S. passport or passport card
- Official birth document issued by a U.S. state, jurisdiction or territory
- Consular Report of Birth Abroad issued by the U.S. Department of State (FS-240)
- Certificate of Birth Abroad (FS-545)
- Certification of Report of Birth of a U.S. Citizen (DS-1350)
- U.S. Certificate of Naturalization
- U.S. Certificate of Citizenship
- Unexpired permanent resident card (I-551)

If you have **never held a Virginia driver's license or ID card**, you must present the following documents to prove your eligibility:

- One proof of identity
- One proof of legal presence
- One proof of your social security number
- Two proofs of Virginia residency
- Current driver's license if you are applying to exchange from a different state
- Proof of name change if your name appears differently on your proof documents
